3 Blk	2H, HB, graphite pencils
3 Blk	soft or medium hard compressed charcoal General's "white charcoal" pencil
3 BlKE	medium or soft hardness vine charcoal
3 Blk	white vinyl eraser
3 BlKE	sandpaper wand
3 BlKE	chamois
3 BlKE	3/8" to 1/2" wide blending stump (optional)
3 Blk	pencil sharpener (optional)

<b>4 BIKE</b>	1 black ink Uniball fine point rollerball pen
<b>2-3 Blk</b>	soft pastels: black, gray, white, ocher, burnt sienna, raw umber, red, yellow, blue
<b>5 Blk</b>	9" x 12" to 11" x 14" drawing pad 8" x 10" sketch pad or scratch paper
<b>back</b>	1: 19.5"x25.5" sheet of Canson Mi-Tientes "Moonstone" pastel drawing paper (cut into ¼'s)
<b>3 Blk</b>	container to carry supplies (optional)
<b>4 Blk</b>	drawing fixative (optional)
<b>back</b>	portfolio to store art (optional)
<b>window (top drawer)</b>	1 sheet glassine paper to separate drawings in your portfolio
<b>8c</b>	gray scale card
<b>Other Optional Items</b>	plumb line, pilot SCA-UF black pen to label supplies, Ziploc snack bags, 4"x6" mirror, 18"x24" Masonite panel (or larger drawing board), #4 bulldog clips, 50 sheets of newsprint ("blanket"), camera, eraser shield, Tombow "Monozero" eraser, pastel pencils
