Express yourself and discover your artistic talents with acrylic paints in this inspiring class for all student levels. Study use of color, observation, composition, light and dark and traditional painting techniques.

MATERIALS LIST

- Art materials and tools
 - Paint: one 2 oz. tube each of red, yellow, blue, black, and white (the Liquitex Basics set in 2.5 fl oz sized tubes will do nicely)
 - Brushes: varying sizes, from fine tip to ca. 1 in.
 - Palette knife (spatula for mixing paint)
 - Pack of canvas paper
- Other
 - Palette: a plastic plate or disposable pint deli container lid will do
 - Water container
 - Plastic table cloth for protecting your table space
 - Notebook or sketchpad and note-taking pen or pencil

Materials and tools can be purchased at University Art Redwood City, the Stanford University Bookstore, or Michaels. Your choice of brands: price and quality ranges from student to professional grade. You are also welcome to use any supplies you already have at home.
